
What is Sudden Cardiac Arrest?


Sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) is a condition in which the heart suddenly and unexpectedly stops beating. If this happens, blood stops flowing to the brain and other vital organs. If the heartbeat is not restored with an electrical shock from a defibrillator immediately, death follows within minutes.

It's the world's biggest killer and it kills over 100,000 people per year in the UK alone. That's one person every 5 minutes! It can happen to anyone, anywhere and at any time.

Causes of sudden cardiac arrest

SCA is unpredictable and really can happen to anyone, any time, anywhere – even to teenagers and yes, even to you!

- Previously suffered a heart attack or heart disease
- A family history of heart problems
- Unknown heart problems
- A victim of asphyxiation (drowning, choking, etc.)
- A victim of electrocution
- Physical stress
- Impact or trauma to the chest.

It's a race against time!

Survival rates drop by over 10% for every minute that passes without defibrillation.


After 10 minutes, the chances of survival are obviously extremely small.

With an automated external defibrillator (AED) on-site, defibrillation can take place within 3 minutes, and on average the chances of survival are drastically increased by up to 70%.

The adult chain of survival

The adult chain of survival is a set of guidelines for the treatment of SCA. By taking the quick action recommended, the chance of saving someone's life is dramatically improved. Is your workplace prepared for a sudden cardiac arrest?
